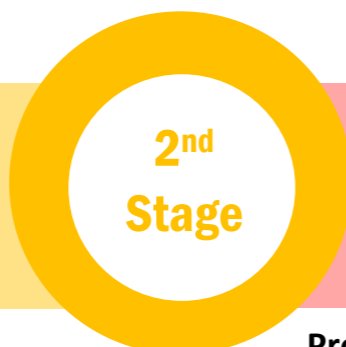

Dementia Friends Awareness Week. Produce resources, and put on sessions for both the school community and our wider community to make them aware of how to support people to live well with dementia.



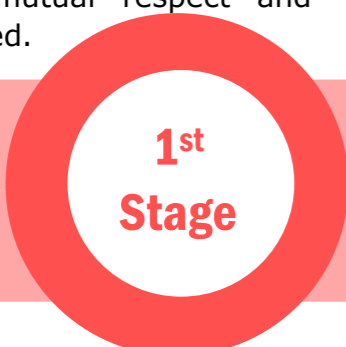
Meet the Team
